A few notes about the Ansteorra youth combat program for those of you
who are unfamiliar with it: Youth (boffer) combat is for boys and
girls age 6 to 15 years. They fight with foam-padded weapons (a/k/a
"boffers"). There are 3 age divisions, within the program, 6-9 years,
10-12 years, and 13-15 years. The armor requirements, and the
strength of blows allowed, increase as a child progresses through the

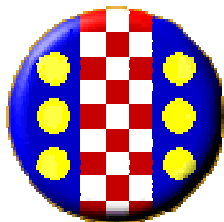


We have moved archery practice to Thursdays 6:30pm to 8:30pm to allow more people to at-

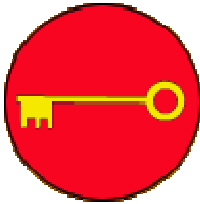
Chronicler's Report
